

Worship Pastor Ministry Description

Parramatta Baptist Church is looking to call a Pastor to join the existing Pastoral team. PBC comprises 3 congregations at its site in Northmead and supports a new church plant in the Parramatta CBD. There are approximately 650 men, women and children who attend our Sunday services, with an average weekly attendance of approximately 450. You can find more about us at: www.parramattabaptist.com

The primary area of pastoral responsibility will be to provide oversight of the congregational worship services and as part of that, spiritual leadership for the team of approximately 70 worship leaders, singers, musicians and technical support teams. The position is part-time (20 hours per week).

More specifically, the Pastor will be expected to:

1. Plan and co-ordinate the congregational worship services consistent with the vision and values of the church.
2. Lead the worship services on a rostered basis and work closely with the other worship leaders (currently 8) providing them with direction, input, feedback and encouragement.
3. Work closely with other Pastors involved in the congregational services to align the worship with the preaching series and other specific themes that may be happening.
4. Provide leadership, equipping and encouragement to the worship leaders, singers and musicians.
5. Work closely with the technical support team leaders to ensure that there is an ongoing healthy relationship between stage and desk.
6. To serve as part of the Pastoral team and participate in scheduled team meetings.

Essential Requirements

1. A passion for being led by God's Spirit, demonstrated by a willingness to listen, wait and be dependent upon Him.
2. A high level of spiritual maturity and the Christ-like character required of those who seek to minister as pastors.
3. Experience in worship leading and strong musical gifts.
4. Experience and skills in leading worship leaders and teams of musicians.
5. Leadership skills in being able to develop and implement vision, communicate clearly, delegate, mentor, motivate, resolve conflict, recruit and equip others for ministry.
6. The ability to work in a team context and be accountable to others.

Accountability

The Pastor is ultimately accountable to the Church community.

This accountability will be achieved by:

4. Meeting with one of the Pastoral Team leaders monthly to report on and review their ministry, receiving direction and/or advice as appropriate.
5. Providing a monthly report on their ministry to the Pastoral team.
6. An annual review with one of the Pastoral Team leaders.

Commencement

7 January 2019. An earlier commencement date may be considered if the circumstances of the successful applicant permit.

Remuneration

A stipend and other benefits will be provided consistent with the Baptist Churches of NSW recommendations and taking into consideration experience and qualifications
