We trust that you have been encouraged this past fortnight by how God responded to the prayers of Daniel and Nehemiah. And we know that God continues to move in response to the prayers of His people to turn lives (and at times nations and leaders of nations) around. So, would you be part of a church-wide movement of prayer over the next 2 months, asking God to move in the places where He has sent you and among the people He has sent you to?

We are inviting you *every Tuesday* through *November and December* to set aside time to *pray*.

You might get up a little earlier, stay up a little later, or use your lunch break. You might set reminders and pray throughout the day in your sent place. You might join with House of Prayer who gather every Tuesday night at church at 7:30pm. Or you might vary it up over the two months.


If you are able to, consider fasting from something each Tuesday. As you miss the thing that you are fasting from, allow that to prompt you to pray. Ask the Lord to show you what to fast from, be that a meal, caffeine, social media, other media, or something else.

We've included in this letter a crafted prayer that you may choose to use, but we encourage to craft your own prayer as the Holy Spirit leads.

The heart behind this is to see lives transformed by Jesus. Asking for a move of God to turn hearts and lives around. Asking for opportunities to make Him known.

Also included is a prayer commitment card. As a way of committing to pray and encouraging others who are committing to pray, we invite you to bring or mail the card to PBC so that we can include it on a "prayer wall" in the auditorium.

We are anticipating all that God will do as we unite in prayer.
