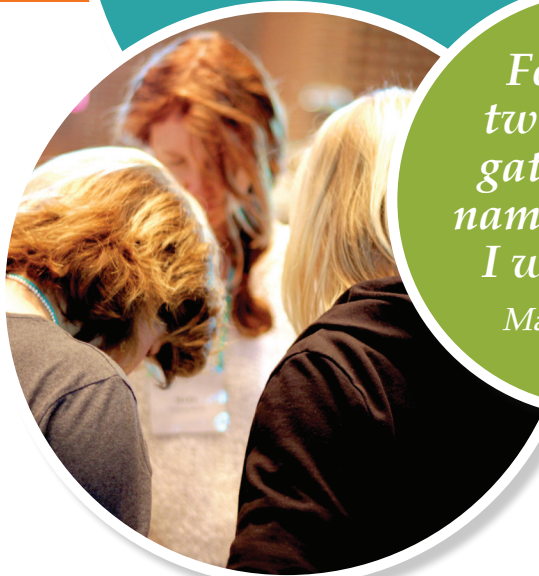
# How prayer works at PBC

We believe that God has called PBC to be a healing community where lives and situations get transformed by Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit. And we are convinced of the role that prayer plays in those transformation stories. God uses ordinary people to do extraordinary things if we have the faith to ask and the commitment to keep asking.

Here are some ways that you can access prayer or be involved in a prayer team at PBC.

## Prayer Appointments

If you are seeking wholeness, restoration, healing or freedom in some way, or blessing as you move into something new, we would love to pray with you. Two or three pray-ers will meet with you at a mutually convenient time through the week for more in-depth prayer than can happen on a Sunday. All prayer will be kept confidential. Team members are also available to pray with you in hospital or to pray through your home, releasing blessing and freedom.
